

## 2025 Junior Tournament Requirements for USTA Georgia National Level 5 Open and Closed

<p><b>Level 5 Open and Closed</b> (High Level Intermediate)</p> <p><b>Tournament Director</b> Must have experience running large tournaments (more than 100 players)</p> <p><b>Officials Required</b> 1 official per 6 courts. Feed-In-Consolation FIC-R16 or FIC-FQ for Singles – <b>Tournament starts on Saturday and finishes on Monday.</b> Best of three tiebreak sets with a 10-Point Match Tiebreak in lieu of the 3<sup>rd</sup> set.</p> <p>ii. Curtis Consolation with 3/4 Playoff ** - <b>Tournament starts on Saturday and finishes on Monday.</b> Best of three tiebreak sets with a 10-Point Match Tie-break in lieu of the 3<sup>rd</sup> set.</p> <p>iii. Flighted Draws – Two or three draws of 16 players in each age group – <b>Doubles start on Friday night. The tournament ends on Sunday.</b> Best of three tiebreak sets with a 10-Point Match Tie-break in lieu of the 3<sup>rd</sup> set. Remember flighted draws require two sets of trophies.</p> <p>b. <b>Doubles:</b> Single Elimination for Doubles.</p> <p>i. <b>Doubles:</b> 8 game pro-set with a 7 point set tiebreak at 8-all. ### Minimum Site Requirements

- Ice and water must be readily available for players at ALL sites where matches are played.
  - Bathroom facilities must be at ALL sites where matches are played.
  - Seating must be provided on-court for players at ALL sites.
- Score tenders or alternative scoring keeping devices on all courts (such as pen and paper must be provided)
  - **SINGLES STICKS ARE REQUIRED** for All sites where matches are played.
    - Lights must be available to use on court
    - **Minimum** number of courts Needed – 32

**All National Level 5 tournaments must provide a Player Gift.**
