Minimum Site Requirements

- Ice and water must be readily available for players at ALL sites where matches are played.
 - Bathroom facilities must be Open at ALL sites where matches are played.
 - Seating must be provided on-court for players at ALL sites.
- Score tenders or alternative scoring keeping devices on all courts (such as pen and paper must be provided)
 - **SINGLES STICKS ARE REQUIRED** for All sites where matches are played.
 - Lights must be available to use on court
 - **Minimum** number of courts Needed – 32

All National Level 5 tournaments must provide a Player Gift.
