Re: 2026 USTA Georgia Adult 65 & Over League Tennis State Championship

USTA Georgia, the Savannah Area Tennis Association and The Landings would like to thank you and your teammates for registering for the 2026 USTA Georgia Adult 65 & Over League Tennis State Championship, which will be held October 9th – 11th, in Savannah, GA. **A player is not allowed to play on two teams in the same level and same age division during the Adult 65 & Over League State Championship, so please be aware of this regulation.** Players who participate on two teams will not be accommodated in scheduling the event.

Registration will be done electronically, so each player will be able to register and pay for themselves. All they will need is their team level and the captain's name. Once the local league coordinator submits the captain and team #, you will receive an email to review your Tennislink roster, the withdrawal and default policies and accept the team deposit fee of \$250. **Your card WILL NOT be charged.** The team deposit form is an authorization to charge the same credit card that was used for player registration in case of a team withdrawal or a default. USTA Georgia does not place "holds" on the credit card. If you are a non-playing captain and will not register for this tournament, click on "non-playing captain approval" and you will receive a separate email to forward the link to the player that will complete your team deposit authorization. **Your team will not be uploaded for registration until you approve it.**

Once your team is uploaded to the registration form, you and your teammates will be able to [register](#). The entry fee is \$47 per player. The deadline for the teams to be registered with at least 6 proper combinations and the deposit hold submitted will be no later than **Wednesday, September 16th**. Any player who registers after Wednesday, September 23rd may not receive the tournament shirt (Please remind your players of this).

The directions page shows which facilities we will be using, and all levels will be scheduled to play on clay courts barring any weather problems. Balls will be provided prior to each match.

The Savannah Area Tennis Association (host CTA) would appreciate your help with your hotel information. This information is critical to obtaining the required rooms and Economic Impact report. Please be sure to fill out the "hotel survey sheet" for (later in this packet) for all your players and submit via email to me. Please be sure your hotel knows you are with the Tennis Tournament.

Please visit the USTA Georgia League State Championship website (www.ustageorgialsc.com) as this site has all the information that is needed. Please remind your players to download the **USTA Georgia League State Championship App** and turn on the "Event Messages", so they can receive alerts throughout the tournament.

The Savannah Area Tennis Association will provide a \$13 meal voucher to be used one time, Friday through Sunday at "The Deck at the Franklin Creek Complex." They will be given to the captain at the captain registration for each registered player.

Awards:	Champion and Finalist teams will receive awards, with all players covered by the entry fee receiving an award.

DIRECTIONS FOR ON-LINE REGISTRATION

1. Confirm with your local league coordinator your team is accepting the berth and the name of the captain (only one name) for the championship.
2. Your local league coordinator submits the captain and team #. You will receive an email to review your Tennislink roster, the withdrawal and default policies and accept the team deposit fee of \$250. **Your card WILL NOT be charged.** The team deposit form is an authorization to charge the same credit card that was used for player registration in case of a team withdrawal or a default. USTA Georgia does not place "holds" on the credit card. If you are a non-playing captain and will not register for this tournament, click on "non-playing captain approval" and you will receive a separate email to forward the link to the player that will complete your team deposit authorization. **Your team will not be uploaded for registration until you approve it.**
3. Once the team is uploaded, Each player [registers](#) using the team level and the captain's name.
4. Each player MUST provide an accurate email and cell phone number, as these will be used if we are able to use our virtual site desk for lineup exchanges and introductions.
5. Each player will select their shirt size during the registration process and there will be NO EXCHANGES after the registration deadline.
6. The initial registration deadline (at least 6 eligible players registered) is **Wednesday, September 16th** at midnight. Any player who registers after **Wednesday, September 23rd** at midnight will NOT receive a shirt (no exceptions).
7. Entry Fee is **\$47 per player** (transaction fee included).



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CAPTAIN'S CHECKLIST

- Captains' Zoom Video Call is Wednesday, October 7th at 7 pm. The link will be emailed to you on the week of the call. This is very important because we will go over all the specific rules that apply for the tournament and the changes for this year. All announcements concerning schedule changes are made at this time. The captain may have a representative on this call if they are unable to attend.
- Email the completed Hotel Information Survey filled out. This is important because it's how our hosts get financial support from their local community.
- Captains' Registration (Check-In) is Thursday, October 8th from 5:00 – 5:30 pm at the Franklin Creek TC, The Landings. It will be a drive-through pick-up.
- Thursday, October 8th at 5:30 pm is the last day to have players registered. Make sure your team is all set by checking the list of players registered: ([Who is Registered](#))
- You will receive a list of players registered for your team and the t-shirt sizes they ordered, along with the meal vouchers. Please make sure the sizes in the bag match the list and you have been given the correct number of meal vouchers. You will also be given car hang tags for each player, which will be needed for them to enter through the gate of The Landings. It is your responsibility to distribute them to your players.
- Make sure you have the USTA Georgia Championships App and you are set up to receive messages and alerts for this tournament. Weather delay updates and important messages will be sent through the app.
- From the app or the Championship website, locate the links for lineup submission and the court assignment sheets. Submit a few test lineups to get familiar with the process.



2026 USTA Georgia League Tennis State Championships Withdrawal & Cancellation Policy

Tournament Withdrawal Policy

Teams that withdraw twenty-two (22) days in advance of the start of the tournament will be reimbursed their security deposit and entry fee (minus \$2 processing fee). Teams that withdraw within twenty-one (21) days of the start of the championship and the posting of the draw will not be reimbursed their entry fee. Teams that withdraw once the draw is posted will forfeit their entry fee and security deposit. Separately, the team will be subject to a grievance filed by the Championship Committee and may receive suspension penalties imposed by the Championship Grievance Committee.

Tournament Cancellation Policy

- *Round Robin Format (flighted format)*
 - Should inclement weather or other circumstances prevent the completion of the State Championship or prevent round robin matches from starting by a specific time as determined by the Championship Committee on the final day of the championship, the level/flight winners will be determined by the first of the following procedures:
 - In the event a level or flight within a level consists of multiple round robins, the first-place team will be determined by TennisLink standings at the conclusion of the most recent full round robin. If no full round robin is completed, the below-mentioned procedures would apply.
 - In the event that only one team in a round robin has a mathematical chance of finishing first, that team will be declared the winner of the round robin.
 - If more than one team has a mathematical chance of winning their round robin, and the first-place team has already beaten the other teams with a mathematical chance of winning, the 1st place team would be considered the round robin winner as the head-to-head winner.
 - If a round robin winner cannot be determined, and each team in a round robin has been given the opportunity to complete a minimum of one team match, only teams with a mathematical chance of finishing first will receive an entry into a drawing. Undefeated teams will receive a second entry into the drawing.
 - If a round robin winner cannot be determined, and each team in a round robin has not been given the opportunity to complete a minimum of one team match, each team will receive one entry into a drawing to determine the round robin winner.
- *Partial Round Robin Matches Format*
 - Should inclement weather or other circumstances prevent the completion of the State Championship or prevent un-flight matches from starting by a specific time as determined by the Championship Committee on the final day of the championship, the winners will be determined by the first of the following procedures that does so:
 - If a minimum of 3 full partial round robin rounds have been completed by all teams, any undefeated teams will receive an entry into a drawing to determine a winner. In this instance, unfinished partial round robin rounds in fourth segment will not count.
 - In the event that only one team (after the most recent full partial round robin round) has a mathematical chance of finishing first, that team will be declared the winner.
 - If more than one team has a mathematical chance of winning, after the most recent full partial round robin round, and the first-place team has already beaten the other teams with a mathematical chance of winning, the first-place team would be considered the winner as the head-to-head winner.
 - If a winner cannot be determined, and each team has been given the opportunity to complete a minimum of one team match, only teams with a mathematical chance of finishing first will receive an entry into a drawing. Undefeated teams will receive a second entry into the drawing.

- *During Playoffs*
 - Should inclement weather or other circumstances prevent the completion of all playoff rounds during the State Championship; the following procedures will be used to determine round robin winners:
 - If cancellation occurs before or during the first round of playoffs, all group winners will receive two entries in the drawing and any best 2nd place teams will receive one entry into the drawing to determine one state champion. Team(s) that have clinched (won a majority of individual matches) in their first round of playoffs will be considered the winner of the playoff match and will also receive two entries into the drawing and the losing team(s) will be excluded from the drawing.
 - If cancellation occurs during the second round of playoffs, all teams that have not had their team match decided will receive an entry in the drawing to determine one state champion. Any winning team that has completed their second-round match will also receive one entry into the drawing and the losing team will be excluded from the drawing.
 - Once the finalists are determined, both teams will be told how the champion will be determined by the USTA Georgia Championship Committee, should cancellation occur after the finals have begun play.
 - If cancellation occurs once the finalists have been determined, but play has not begun, both teams can agree to meet at a mutual location and time to play for the state championship. A deadline will be given by the Championship Committee to complete the match. If both teams cannot agree to a mutual location and time prior to or on the deadline set forth by the Championship Committee, both teams will receive an entry in the drawing to determine one state champion. USTA Georgia will not be responsible for providing an official or for any expenses related to this match.

Frequently Asked Questions about the State Championships

If you have a question about the 2026 USTA Georgia League Tennis State Championships; refer to this sheet as a handy reference.

1. Our team won both the fall/winter and spring/summer seasons, but a couple of our players were different. Can we take all our players?

No. You must choose which season you are representing - the fall/winter or the spring/summer. Only those players on that roster, and who are otherwise qualified, may play. You cannot combine rosters.

2. How many matches does a player have to have played locally to be eligible to participate at the USTA Georgia Adult 65 & Over League State Championship?

A player must have played one match during the same local league season, including local playoffs, in which his/her team qualified for the state championship. One default received by the player during local competition shall count for advancing. A retired match shall count toward advancing for all players involved. If there is no local competition offered during the entire championship year, a team may advance directly to the USTA Georgia Adult 65 & Over League Tennis State Championship as an "Area Team" without playing any matches. However, all players must meet the requirements of participating on an "Area Team." (see regulations)

3. How soon can we get our match schedule?

The tentative schedule will be posted on the USTA Georgia Web Page (www.ustageorgialsc.com) or on [TennisLink](#) at least one week before the tournament starts. The final schedule will be emailed to the captain the Wednesday prior to the start of the championship.

4. Why do I have to be on the captain's zoom video call?

On the captain's zoom video call we go over all the specific rules that apply for the tournament. All announcements concerning schedule changes are made at this time. The captain's zoom video call is the only way we can ensure you are informed of changes or special situations you need to know about to make your tournament as smooth as possible. The captain may have a representative on the zoom video call and/or attend the captain's registration.

5. Our team only has four players available. Will we have to default all our matches?

You must have a minimum of six players who can play all three positions, but if the Tournament Committee approves this prior to the tournament your team will be allowed to play with only 4 players for the entire tournament. These defaults would be subject to the default rule (see #6).

6. What is the Default rule for the State Championships?

Any team defaulting a court for any reason will incur a fee of \$100 per court defaulted. Teams will pay with the credit card on file for the deposit, or teams may choose to use cash and/or another credit card (additional \$4 processing fee if paid by credit card) if they choose to do so. If a team doesn't pay their fee, it will be charged to the credit card used to register for the state championship by the individual who submitted the authorization form. The reason for this regulation is it's your team's responsibility to have players on every court at each match during a state championship. When a team defaults a line, it not only can affect the outcome of the championship, but more importantly, it affects those players who showed up ready to play, only to find their opponents did not show. Any money collected from defaults will be given to the CTA hosting the state championship in which the defaults occurred. An appeal of this fee may be made to the USTA Georgia Adult League Committee and under extreme circumstances will be considered.

*** Players must play at the level their rating was on the roster at the time of their local league play!**

From ***I-95 Southbound, exit 99A*** (I-16 East) approximately 6 miles to exit #164A (Lynes Parkway/Hwy 516). Continue 5 1/2 miles (name changes to DeRenne) to Waters Ave. Turn RIGHT on Waters and stay on for 8 miles (road name changes to Whitfield and Diamond Causeway). Go straight into main gate of The Landings, then through gate and bear right on Landings Way South. Go 1/4 mile to "Franklin Creek" sign. Turn RIGHT and follow straight into club.

From ***I-95 Northbound, exit 94*** (GA HWY 204/Abercorn). Turn RIGHT at end of ramp and continue for approximately 9 miles. Turn slight RIGHT on North Truman Parkway. Continue for approximately 2 miles to Whitfield Ave. exit. Turn right onto Whitfield Ave. (Road name changes to Diamond Causeway). Go straight into main gate of The Landings, then through gate and bear right on Landings Way South. Go 1/4 mile to "Franklin Creek" sign. Turn RIGHT and follow straight into club.

To Marshwood Tennis Center from Franklin Creek Tennis Center

The Landings, 1 Palmer's Draw, Savannah, GA 31411

Go out to Landings Way and turn LEFT. Stay on Landings Way, past the main gate exit, a total of 2 3/4 miles & turn LEFT at the "Marshwood" sign onto Palmer's Draw. Go past the Clubhouse on your right and continue to the far end of parking lot and the courts are on your left.

To Oakridge Club from Franklin Creek Tennis Center

Go out to first stop sign and turn RIGHT on Franklin Creek Road South. At first stop sign, turn RIGHT on West Cross. Proceed over bridge, a total of 9/10 mile to the "Oakridge" Club sign on the right. Turn RIGHT. Go through the Fitness Center (2nd entrance on right) to access the tennis courts.
