JTT's back alright! COTA is excited to reestablish their JTT program, and participating juniors had the opportunity to compete in match play and win door prizes at the kick-off event.

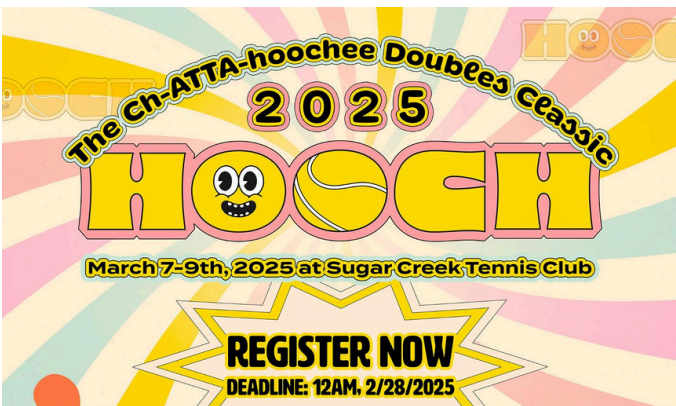
DISTRICT 3
