Level 5 Open and Closed (High Level Intermediate) Tournament Director Must have experience running large tournaments (more than 100 players) Officials Required 1 official per 6 courts is always the minimum requirement. This does not include the referee. Recommendation 1 per 4 courts.	a. Singles: i. Feed-In-Consolation FIC-R16 (32 draw) or FIC-Q (16 draw) for Singles – Tournament starts on Saturday and finishes on Monday. Best of three tiebreak sets with a 10-Point Match Tiebreak in lieu of the 3rd set. ii. Curtis Consolation (64 Draw) with 3/4 Playoff ** - Tournament starts on Saturday and finishes on Monday. Best of three tiebreak sets with a 10-Point Match Tie-break in lieu of the 3rd set. iii. Flighted Draws – Two or three draws of 16 players in each age group – Doubles start on Friday night. The tournament ends on Sunday. Best of three tiebreak sets with a 10-Point Match Tie-break in lieu of the 3rd set. Remember flighted draws require more sets of trophies. b. Doubles: Single Elimination for Doubles. i. Doubles: 8 game pro-set with a 7 point set tiebreak at 8-all. No ¾ play-off. All doubles players must play in the same division as they do in singles. No ad scoring. **Use of the 64 Curtis Consolation Draw on Level 5's must be approved by the USTA Southern office. Minimum Site Requirements

- Ice and water must be readily available for players at ALL sites where matches are played.
 - Bathroom facilities must be Open at ALL sites where matches are played.
 - Seating must be provided on-court for players at ALL sites.
- Score tenders or alternative scoring keeping devices on all courts (such as pen and paper must be provided)
 - **SINGLES STICKS ARE REQUIRED** for All sites where matches are played.
 - Lights must be available to use on court
 - **Minimum** number of courts Needed – 32
